Our work is currently focused in Kengeri, located in South-West Bengaluru. We care for stray dogs and cats in the area through daily feeding, rescuing injured and sick animals, medical care, ensuring timely vaccination & sterilization and educating the public on responsible treatment of community animals.

Our Goals for 2025

Sterilize and vaccinate over 250 streeties to control the population humanely and prevent diseases

Sterilized and vaccinated 140 dogs & 20 cats

Our Goals for 2026

S: STERILIZE



1. Work in Doddabele, Anchepalya and Kumbalgod areas in Kengeri to conduct sterilization for atleast 200 dogs (These are all Gram Panchayat areas: so NIL ABC + growing population)

Cost Estimation: Rs.4,00,000/-

2. Work with various institutions, organizations, factories in the Kengeri and surrounding regions to vaccinate and sterilize all their community dogs and cats

Ground level efforts will be handled by Sneha Saathi while funds will be raised by the institutions

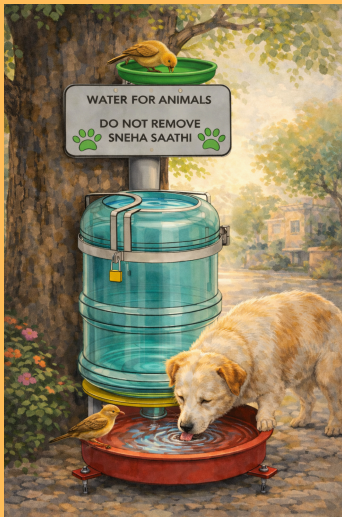
Create awareness reels and have education programs with the following goals:

R: RESCUE



1. Sneha Saathi Mobile ambulance/"vet on wheels" to provide on-spot treatment for street animals.

Key Highlights of the ambulance:

- 2 cages, emergency stretcher on the roof
- 2 folding seats for staff members,
- A foldable working table to treat animals
- Emergency oxygen, a drugs cabinet with IV set up, a small sink and all other basic material required for treatment.
- Medical Waste disposal bin

Cost Estimation for the mobile ambulance: Rs.6,50,000/-

2. Work with the GBA in Bangalore to release an automatic water dispenser for streeties, specially designed to be strong, easy to transport, theft-resistant, easy to clean & refilling once in 4-5 days.

Initial Setup Cost/ Trials/ Promotions : Rs.40,000/-

3. Work with the GBA in Bangalore to release an automatic gravity feeder for community street dogs to ensure reliable food access in areas that have no feeders. The feeder is designed to provide daily food while minimizing aggression, contamination, and operational effort.

Initial Setup Cost/ Trials/ Promotions: Rs.40,000/-

1. Deworm, Vaccinate & Protect at least 100 puppies and young dogs from deadly illnesses like rabies, parvo, and distemper

2. While we will continue vaccinating adult dogs, our goal will be to see lesser puppies through our successful sterilization efforts

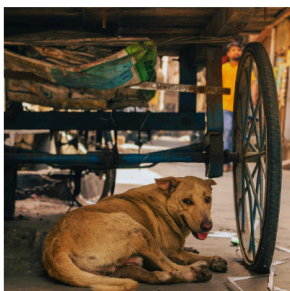

- **Brings** population under control, reduced number of puppies on the streets
- **Reduces** spread of diseases and most importantly '**rabies**' in adult dogs because of the vaccinations given
- **Reduces** aggression and fights amongst dogs, especially with males fighting over females in heat.
- **Protects** puppies against deadly diseases, with a stronger immunity system they have a better chance at life
- **Lesser** transmission and outbreak of diseases amongst animals
- **Public safety**-especially children are protected from dog bites as there is no transmission of rabies
